

Driving Directions to Wyndham Pittsburgh University Center

From the East via the PA Turnpike or Monroeville, PA: Take Exit 57 Pittsburgh from the PA Turnpike. Follow signs for downtown Pittsburgh and take I-376 West. Follow I-376 to the Bates Street exit (PA-885 N). Merge onto Bates Street toward Oakland and travel on Bates Street just over one mile. Turn left onto S. Bouquet Street and travel to Forbes Avenue. Turn right onto Forbes Avenue and then turn left onto Bigelow Blvd. Travel on Bigelow Blvd past the Cathedral of Learning on your right. After crossing Fifth Avenue, continue on Bigelow past the Soldier's & Sailors' Memorial on your left to the next intersection where Bigelow Blvd. turns right. Turn right to stay on Bigelow Blvd. and then turn right at the first cross street onto Lytton Avenue. The hotel will be on the left.

From the West & Pittsburgh Int'l Airport: Follow Airport Exit signs to I-376E/US-22 E/US 30 E. Stay on I-376E/US-22 E/US 30 E for approximately 6 miles to the Fort Pitt Tunnel. Go through the Fort Pitt tunnel and over the Fort Pitt Bridge, bearing right to follow I-376 east toward Monroeville. Take the Oakland Exit onto Forbes Avenue. Travel on Forbes Avenue and turn left onto Bigelow Blvd. Travel on Bigelow Blvd past the Cathedral of Learning on your right. After crossing Fifth Avenue, continue on Bigelow past the Soldier's & Sailors' Memorial on your left to the next intersection where Bigelow Blvd. turns right. Turn right to stay on Bigelow Blvd. and then turn right at the first cross street onto Lytton Avenue. The hotel will be on the left.
